Potential Responsibilities:

- Assist in developing evaluation scopes of work and serve on evaluation teams for performance and/or impact evaluations.
- Ensure project data are appropriately geographically coded for GIS applications; assist in maintaining GIS database.
- Prepare summaries of performance data and generate reports both on schedule and in response to ad hoc requests with a focus on effective graphical display of data.
- Contribute to assessments on issues affecting youth; marginalized groups; persons with disabilities; and trafficked individuals.
- Contribute to the design and analysis of regular public opinion surveys.
